### Requirements for Innovation Catalyst Certification

## 1. Presentation & Facilitation Competency:

Our Innovation Catalyst Certification process is designed to provide Catalysts with the principles, tools, and skills needed to deliver powerful training sessions. The training experience requires powerful presentation and team facilitation skills in order to provide a successful training experience.

#### 2. Passion & Knowledge of Innovation:

As ambassadors of innovation for their organization, Catalysts should have an intrinsic passion for innovation and a desire to deepen their knowledge and understanding of the field's principles and best practices.

- 3. Organizational Buy-in: Catalysts will maximize their impact when they have commitment from their organization. Catalysts should come with full support and sponsorship to take the training more broadly across their organization. The training will cover best practices for building a culture and capability of innovation to assist the Trainer once they return to their organization.
- 4. Technical Understanding: The Trainer Certification includes a license to all of our tools, including an e-presentation platform, virtual course, videos, and innovation management software. Catalysts should come with the expectation that they will learn and become proficient in new tools.

#### The Innovator's DNA Certification Process

### 1. Novice Certification

- Attend the full course as a traditional participant
- Complete the Trainer Certification session
- Demonstrate proficiency with the core content, base-level facilitation and presentation skills, and understanding of the training tools

#### 2. Full Certification

- Teach three courses within the first twelve months
- Submit course reviews from each initial session for review with your Master Trainer

### 3. Continuous Personal Development

- Teach training courses as frequently as possible
- Stay involved with the Innovator's DNA community and its resources—continue to learn and add to your teaching repertoire





## Frequently Asked Questions

#### Q. What does the certification course include?

The Trainer Certification course provides additional detail and understanding behind the principles and tools taught in the course and includes the following:

- Course Content Review. The primary focus of the certification will to ensure that Catalysts have a strong foundational understanding of the core concepts and principles taught in our courses. This will include a Trainer Assessment, in-depth review, and application of the concepts taught in the original workshop.
- Facilitation & Application. Facilitation best practices and expert use of our teaching tools and methods will be covered, accompanied by a personal development plan for each Catalyst to follow as a part of their provisional certification.
- Teachback Practice. Each participant will have the opportunity to select a portion of the course content to prepare and teach back to their peers and the Master Trainer.
- Tools & Resources. Catalysts will receive a number of exclusive tools and resources designed to ensure their success as facilitators and trainers, including the Catalyst e-Presentation Platform and Catalyst Zone, and will go through training on how to use each tool.
